**“Global CEO of the Year” Win for MRCB Group Managing Director
Tan Sri Mohamad Salim Fateh Din at the 6th Middle East Business Leaders
Awards 2015**

Kuala Lumpur Sentral CBD, 30 November 2015 – Malaysian Resources Corporation Berhad (MRCB) is pleased to announce that its Group Managing Director, Tan Sri Mohamad Salim Fateh Din was selected as Global CEO of the Year at the 6th Middle East Business Leaders Awards (MEBLA) 2015.

YBhg Tan Sri Mohamad Salim Fateh Din came out tops in the “Global CEO of the Year” award category in this award programme organized by The Leaders International, a high profiled business magazine based in Malaysia and endorsed by American Leadership Development Association (ALDA), a United States based NGO which showcases global leadership at large. This year’s MEBLA presentation ceremony for the winners was held at a gala dinner event at the Armani Hotel in Dubai.

The award is a recognition of his more than 30 years of involvement and achievements in the Malaysian property sector especially since he took over the helm of MRCB in 2013, where he continues to grow this established brand name and bring the organization to a whole new level, while adding value to MRCB as a Transport Oriented Developer and a major construction player in the country.

Speaking on his MEBLA win, YBhg Tan Sri Mohamad Salim Fateh Din said, “I thank MRCB’s Board of Directors for putting their trust in me, as well as their guidance through the challenges we face. Personally, my aim on assuming leadership of this premier property player was to fast track ongoing projects before bidding for new ones, while embarking on some exciting property projects on existing land banks”.

“I will continue to build on MRCB’s strengths and will commit myself and the able workforce of MRCB to deliver various infrastructures that support the national economic development agenda”, added YBhg Tan Sri Mohamad Salim Fateh Din.

Under YBhg Tan Sri Mohamad Salim Fateh Din’s helm, MRCB has been eyeing other choice lands in urban centres throughout the country to replicate its highly successful 28.8-hectare (72-acre) Kuala Lumpur Sentral Central Business District, which will complete in 2016 at a massive development value of RM15 billion.

His effort to secure new business for MRCB has been tremendous with the three latest projects being a RM1.6 billion land swap contract for the National Sports Centre (NSC) in Bukit Jalil, a RM270 million joint venture with Cyberview Sdn Bhd to develop Cyberjaya City Centre, and a RM3.2 billion project management and turnkey contract for Kwasa Utama urban commercial development, which forms part of the Kwasa Damansara Township.

Since the start of his leadership of MRCB, the company has also garnered more Transport Oriented Development (TODs) projects in the country, which were secured on the strength of MRCB’s premier Kuala Lumpur Sentral CBD development. These TOD projects comprise the Penang Sentral public transportation hub in the north, Kwasa Sentral in the new Kwasa Damansara township and the PJ Sentral Garden City developments here in the Klang Valley.

Regarded as YBhg Tan Sri Mohamad Salim Fateh Din’s premier urban regeneration development, PJ Sentral Garden City will bring a welcome change to the landscape of Petaling Jaya and enhance its connectivity via public transportation, including the LRT line. It is envisioned as a catalyst for the rejuvenation of Petaling Jaya, the first ever modern township in the Klang Valley that was opened in 1952.

The project seeks to establish a new vision for the urban regeneration of Petaling Jaya based on the principles of modern design excellence, as well as provisions for social and economic well-being that gives cognizance to environmental responsibility.

Other developments that will be launched in the near term by MRCB is the newly acquired land from the German Embassy in Jalan Kia Peng where a new development will commence next year.

All these follow closely on the heels of MRCB's premier new mixed residential/commercial development on Old Klang Road, the recently launched 9 Seputeh.

He believes in working with all his staff as a team in building the company's success and he extends his motivational reach beyond MRCB's business to include young corporate leaders and communities in the vicinity of the company's operations.

A fine example is YBhg Tan Sri Mohamad Salim Fateh Din's CSR-driven project to build three 1Malaysia Libraries for Klang Valley communities in Kampung Kerinchi, Taman Medan Idaman and Kampung Pandan, together with a centre for the homeless in Jalan Pahang all of which cost RM40 million to build.

YBhg Tan Sri Mohamad Salim Fateh Din's other CSR-driven initiatives include ongoing social enhancement efforts for communities along Jalan Tun Sambanthan and Little India, as well as the whole of Brickfields, in the vicinity of MRCB's Kuala Lumpur Sentral CBD development.

Under his leadership, MRCB continues to contribute to many worthwhile causes in the other states, such as Pahang, Pulau Pinang and Perak, particularly in term of education for the young generation.

In his personal capacity, YBhg Tan Sri Mohamad Salim Fateh Din has contributed to many philanthropic causes, which include donations to down syndrome patients, the needy and underprivileged, orphanages, terminally ill children, as well sponsoring *umrah* and the Haj pilgrimage for the poor.

YBhg Tan Sri Mohamad Salim Fateh Din currently also sits on the boards of Gapurna group of companies, which first propelled him into the property sector. He is also the Chairman of British American Tobacco (Malaysia) Berhad.
